

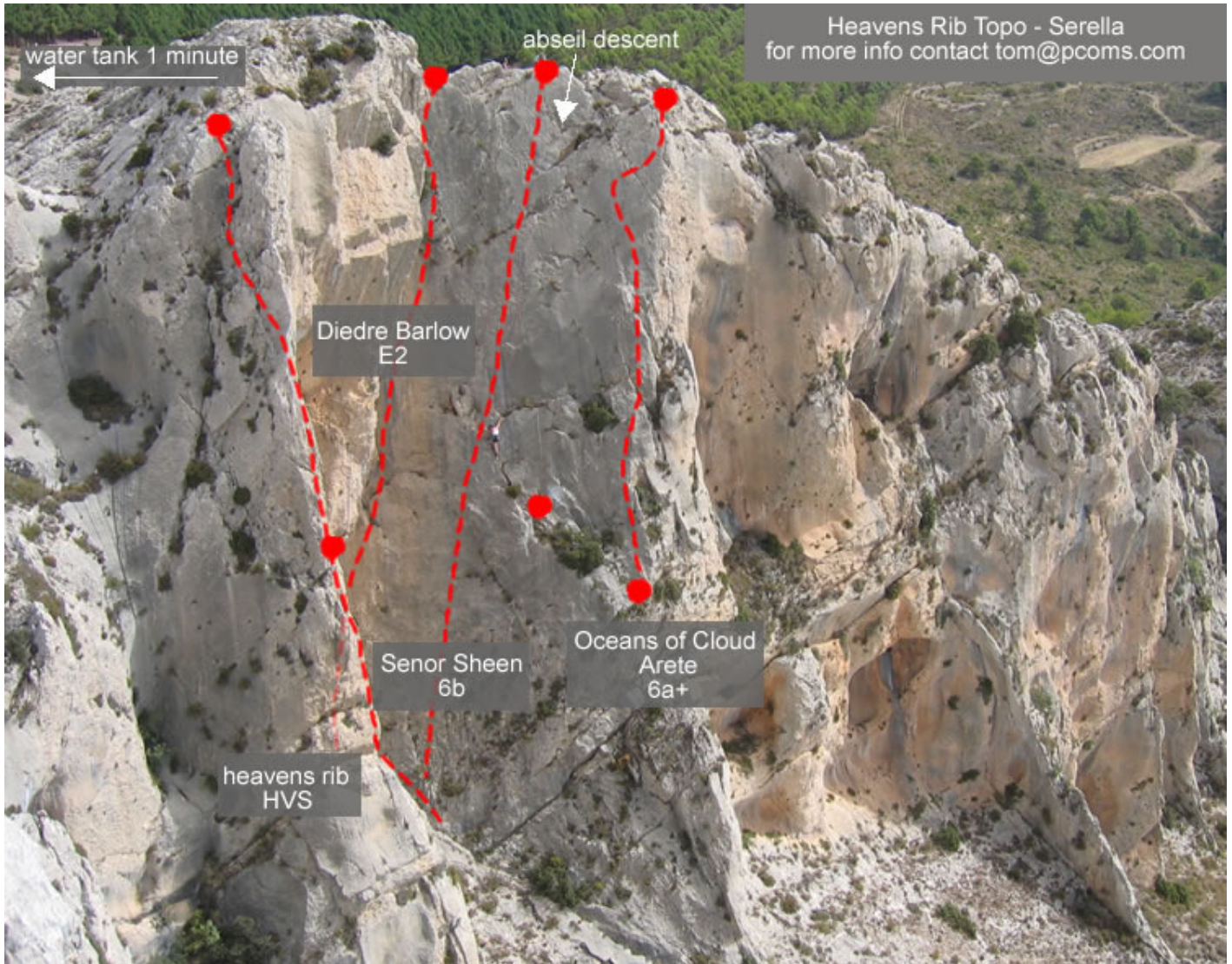

Access: As of August 2008 it is possible to drive close to the crag. Follow CV 70 Past Confrides to the highest point of the road. Turn right onto forest track just before a large house with wind generator. Follow this for 2.7 kms to park on the last hairpin before a large green water tank. From this hairpin traverse across to the butress (5 minutes). Please take care not to trample the delicate plants! All routes have twin ring lower offs.

This crag is approached by parking near the green water tank and walking South to the top of the crag. Abseil down main slab, there is a re-belay half way down centre of the slab so you can use a single rope. You can see this crag from the CV70, the arête and slab are very obvious features.

Heaven Rib, HVS 5a, 4c, 50 metres.

Tackles the obvious rib in a great position at a surprisingly easy grade.

- 1) 20 metres. Climb the scoop feature and then make a tricky move to gain the wall and a ring belay.
- 2) 30 metres. Direct up the arête/rib past a thread until it is possible to move left into a scoop (bolt) and then an easy gully to the top (bolt belay).

First Ascent T. Phillips, R. Edwards

Diedre Barlow, E2 5b, 45 metres.

Climb the slab (bolt) and gain the corner, follow this to the top, protection is medium/large cams, and is widely spaced at times.

First Ascent T. Phillips, M Brohan

Señor Sheen, 6b, 45 metres

The huge slab, passing 15 bolts.

First Ascent T. Phillips, M Brohan

Oceans of Cloud Arête, 6a+

Great climbing on the edge of the slab, with a couple of hard sections, the top slab has a VERY thin move but is very well protected. Approach by abseil to the belay point on the edge of the main slab.
